Kevin Rozzoli AM served in the Legislative Assembly in New South Wales for 30 years as the Member for Hawkesbury. For many years he promoted a single river authority to tackle the complex planning and administrative challenges facing the Hawkesbury-Nepean river system resulting, in 1993, in the establishment of the Hawkesbury-Nepean Catchment Management Trust. He was Deputy Chairman until 2000. He has been Deputy Chairman of the Hawkesbury Nepean Aquatic Weeds Task Force and a member of the Regional Advisory Committees for Hawkesbury REP 20(2) and the Sydney Drinking Water Catchment REP.

Currently Chair of the WISER Project Steering Group, the main working party of the UWS Hawkesbury centre of the CRC Irrigation Futures he is working to establish a national centre for peri-urban water research. He is also Chair of the Great River Walk Inc. and East Bend Rural

Communications, an environmental group at Maroota. He has visited the UK to study river systems including the Mersey, Thames and Parrett. He has written articles for the Sydney Morning Herald on planning and environment and written a number of papers.
